We use a Julian date code system, 5 digit number. On the bottles for example you will see "19241", that means that bottle was ran on the 241st day of 2019.

On the carton we will put a number like this, N199 x05 19241. N199 is the formula number, x05 means that is our 5th batch of that product this year and then followed by the Julian date code.
